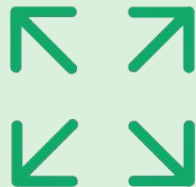
Why - from a PostgreSQL perspective

Why - from an industry perspective

- The IT industry relies heavily on standardization (at scale)
- This includes industry standard certification
- Certificate indicates a predefined skill level
- Fragmented certification programmes

- A necessary step in PostgreSQL's evolution

- Define various categories



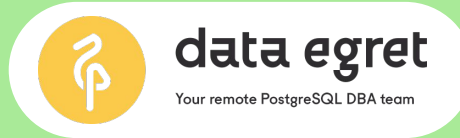
How - the basics

- PostgreSQL certified DBA
- 3 launching companies
- 1 distinct goal

- OAPE does
 - Define PostgreSQL Certified DBA
 - Curriculum
 - Exam
- OAPE does not
 - Train candidates



How - next phase

- Finish initial phase of OAPE
- Recruit members
- Recruit candidates
- Recruit sponsors
- Working on exam
- Schedule dates for first exam
